After continuous displacements, Joan Miró fixed his residence in Mallorca, to which he had traveled as a child and where he arrived to settle in 1956. Then Miró saw his dream come true: the Sert Studio became built.

It is a representative building in Mallorca and has been declared a Site of Cultural Interest (BIC). A unique space for photoshooting and intimate or small-format events.

Prices do not include VAT. 50% of the price must be paid when the booking is made so as to reserve the chosen facilities and the remaining 50% prior to the beginning of the event.
